Project goal – to renew Klaipeda, Kaunas, Siauliai, Alytus, Panevezys and Vilnius orphanages for children with developmental disorders by accommodating their basic and most urgent needs.

PROJECT RESULTS

The most needed medical equipment and the minivan to transport the children were purchased for the Lithuanian orphanages for children with developmental disorders which participated in the project. Also, the facilities were renovated and the playground was equipped too.

THE PROJECT

The project involved not only the most disadvantaged children and infants with developmental disorders in Lithuania, but also those left without parental care.

There are 6 orphanages for children with developmental disorders in Lithuania, accommodating children who were left without parental at early age - from birth to 7 year olds. In most cases the future of orphans with developmental disorders depends on the kindness of

After visiting orphanages in Lithuania we realized that the funding provided by the State and Municipalities is not enough at all to maintain the orphanages and satisfy basic needs of the children.

Children, living at the orphanages, do not have parents to protect them, to ask and look for help; therefore it is US taking care of them.

The aim of this project is to help the orphanages, where the most vulnerable members of our future society are raised, by giving them the opportunity to afford the means for child's everyday activities, development or learning.



INSTITUTIONS INVOLVED

1. BI Klaipeda orphanage for children with developmental disorders.

The Head of the Klaipeda orphanage Mrs. Ausra Nikolajeviene named the basic items that at this moment are needed the most:

- ✓ special pediatric beds;
- ✓ wheelchairs for children.

2. VSI Kaunas Children's Rehabilitation Hospital "Lopselis" (Nursery)

The Head of the "Lopselis" Mrs. Audrone Prasauskiene, mentioned the items that are needed, but cannot be afforded at this moment:

- ✓ child's sensory processing pattern "Sensory profile 2";
- ✓ books scholarly literature, to be used by the "Lopselis" medical staff and other specialists while working with children with different developmental disorders and special needs;
- ✓ E-LINK module system to diagnose patients' functional status.

The Head of the Siauliai orphanage Mrs. Audrone Kardasiene has been dreaming about a new vehicle for a very long time:

√ 6 passenger minivan to transport the children

4. Orphanage for children with developmental disorders in Alytus district

The Head of the Alytus orphanage Mrs. Danguole Jazepcikienė as a priority named the renovation of the bathrooms in "Nykstukai" group at the orphanage and their adaptation to the needs of disabled children.

5. Algimantas Bandza orphanage in Panevezys

The Head of the Panevezys orphanage Mr. Sigitas Juodzevicius explained, that there are children with very serious medical conditions and disorders at the orphanage. Special therapeutic equipment would make the work of caregivers and medical staff so much easier:

√ therapeutic chair and a standing frame for alleviation of the daily care of disabled children.

6. Vilnius orphanage for children with developmental disorders

The community of the Vilnius orphanage for children with developmental disorders wished to allocate the support received to renovate the playground. Currently the asphalt at the yard of the institution is old and is not safe for children to play. It is important to renew the territory and to equip the playground with soft





surface so the children, who spend a lot of time outdoors in any weather conditions would play safely out there.

We STRIVE to bring together Lithuanian companies to provide joint support to the Lithuanian orphanages for children with developmental disorders to ensure that they can satisfy the needs of disadvantaged and vulnerable children residing there - to provide full-scale social services and healthcare.

PROJECT COMPLETION IN KLAIPEDA

The charity project for the Klaipeda orphanage for children with developmental disorders was finalized by visiting the orphanage along with the sponsors of the project.

The promised equipment – new lucent over bed canopy, 5 multifunctioning pediatric beds and two wheelchairs are being used reasonably at the orphanage. The beds are very comfortable for children with special needs forced to stay in bed all the time, they also simplify the work of the social workers as well as are spacious and multi functioning. Wheelchairs will enable children to be outside more often. Lucent over bed canopy, used in the sensory room, will help children to calm down. EUR 9 850 was spent to acquire the new equipment.

PROJECT COMPLETION IN SIAULIAI

We have ended with Siauliai municipality orphanage for children with developmental disorders the project initiated by the Foundation a year ago, intended for meeting basic needs of Lithuanian orphanages for children with developmental disorders.

Thanks to our sponsors – **UAB Sigmaris, UAB Kesvalda, MøllerGruppen Baltic Foundation** – and others who wanted to remain anonymous, 8 passenger van was donated to the orphanage in Siauliai. Amount allocated was EUR 10 000.

During the official closing of the project the orphanage staff expressed their joy that the van has improved everyday reality for children, because finally not only they can safely reach healthcare institutions, but also attend various therapy classes intended to promote their development.









PROJECT COMPLETION IN VILNIUS
